# St. Rita School: Accepting Applications 2014-2015 School Year

#### ST. RITA SCHOOL TO OFFER THE IB-PYP

St. Rita School has been approved as an International Baccalaureate Candidate School. This designation gives the school complete access to the IB-network, including curriculum materials and teacher-training opportunities. The school will now be assigned an IB consultant who will guide the school through the implementation of the program (beginning in August 2014) and the preparation of the application to be certified as an official IB World School offering the Primary Years Program (PYP) which is one of three possible IB programs that can be offered. This process typically takes 12-18 months. During that time, the school continues to have full-access to all IB materials, thereby allowing it to implement the program effectively. The final certification is primarily dependent upon the school's success in implementing the program. Once this certification is granted, St. Rita School will become one of only twelve Catholic K-8 schools nationwide to offer this program ... and the first school of any kind to offer the program in Marin County.
