Please call the rectory before or during your meeting with the funeral director.

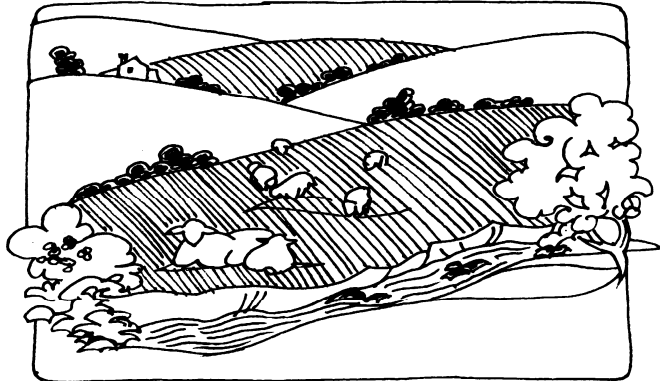
St. Rita Parish Hall

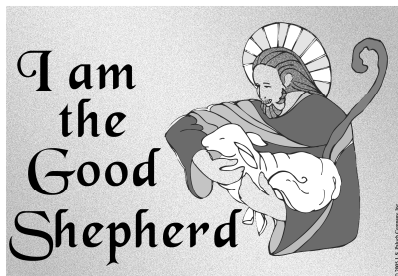
